TERMS AND CONDITIONS

This Business Permit may be revoked or canceled and the establishment may be ordered closed or padlocked with the imposition of appropriate penalties, either by fine or imprisonment or both for violation(s) of Ordinance No. 3057, as amended, otherwise known as the Local Tax Code of Cagayan de Oro or other ordinances, laws, rules and regulations.

These violations include but are not limited to:

- Habitual delinquency in payment of taxes and other fees.
 - Failure or refusal to issue a Sales Invoice for every sale of P20.00 or more. In case of a business establishment having a total gross yearly sales of P20,000.00 or more, a Sales Invoice shall be issued for every sale regardless of the amount.
 - Failure or refusal to display Business Permit and other papers relative to business operations.
 - Failure or refusal to declare the true and correct gross sales receipt.
- Construction, erection of establishments and maintenance of billiard halls, bowling alleys, social halls, recreation halls, mahjong parlors, bars, night clubs, saloons, cabarets, motels, cocktail lounges, beerhouses, discotheque joints, discos, pubs, massage clinics and sauna baths within 200 linear meters from any institution of learning or charity, provided that the dancing school, bar, saloon, pool/billiard halls, bowling alley and other similar establishments operating within 200 linear meters but beyond the prohibitive distance of 50 linear meters under R.A. 1224 from any public building, school, hospital and church shall be permitted to sell liquor, beer, and other intoxicating beverages, or allow playing of mahjong, billiards and other games or show video movies, and/or allow dancing, as the case may be under the following hours of business:
 - For those near government office, church, and exclusive schools, 6:00 P.M. to 1:00 A.M.
 - For those near public plazas and athletic stadiums, 7:00 P.M. to 1:00 A.M.
 - For those near public non-exclusive schools, colleges, hospitals, libraries, and any institution of learning or charity, 8:00 P.M. to 1:00 A.M.
 Provided, further, that subject establishments shall post a sign for the allowed selling or operating hours; that in all cases, minors shall be prohibited from entering therein; furthermore, that all other establishments mentioned above and already existing prior to the approval of Ordinance No. 2362, series of 1989, as amended, may be allowed to operate during the regulated hours.
- Construction, erection, or putting up of any structure, shanty, "barong-barong," shed, table, or pushcart for the purpose of selling, hawking, peddling, or keeping wares in or along the sidewalks, alleys, aisles, or corridors of public markets and in the Integrated Bus Terminal, as well as on the streets or in places immediately surrounding the said establishment.
- Non-compliance with the other rules and regulations applicable thereto.

Most importantly, a Business Permit shall be immediately renewed upon expiration thereof if the operator still desires to continue his/her business; otherwise, the same is considered as operating without a business permit, thus illegal and punishable, aside from the order of closure and padlocking of the establishment.
